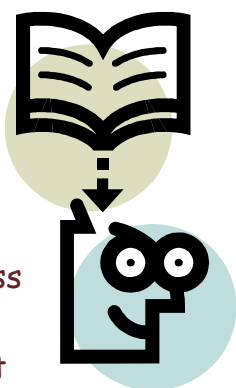
Anchorage Captain's Report

All cabins can sleep 4, they have basic benches and tables however you will need to supply your own pillows & sheets, there is a gas cooker in each, however you will need your own esky to keep the necessaries cold. Prices are North & South cabins (the larger ones) \$15 per cabin & the East & West \$12 per cabin per night, guests are allowed to use the cabins (except at X Mas, Easter & long weekends) and an extra charge of \$5 per head per night is applicable.

Tipplers Update

Finally a light at the end of the tunnel, hopefully, the GCCC has agreed to not demolish the Tipplers Tavern and have decided to finally listen to the community on the issue.

The Marine Action Group has lobbied for over two years to have Tipplers opened as a usable boaties and tourist destination, to make it viable a barefoot bar and bistro needed to be part of the outcome, unfortunately council felt that a cafe serving restricted low alcohol beverages with a meal was the way forward however the majority of councillors have now been convinced that the bar and bistro was a much better option than a sterile cafe. There is still plenty of work do be done by the group before it can all come to fruition and there is still plenty of unreasonable obstacles being thrown up by some councillors however the tunnel at least now has a light on.

It is envisaged that a not for profit group will take control of the site and maybe some of the other island services as well with the likelihood that the bar will be up and running by X mas, the vision is to have all profits invested back into improvements on the site with marine training areas, student visitation areas, overnight cabins etc etc operating.
